

Guidance for use of PfA Template

This Information should be used in conjunction with the "Preparing for Adulthood ReviewTemplate – Draft User Guidance".

As every patient's journey will be different in relation to the service they are offered, the young person's level of understanding, health needs and wishes, there is no prescriptive checklist to complete. There should be a personalised approach to Preparing for Adulthood/Transition, and this should be reflected in the free text boxes within the template. These are the topics of conversation and rationale to think about at each stage (as a minimum). If the person predominantly has support due to capacity/cognition, these themes need to be discussed with Family/Carers.

These conversations can be part of a standalone treatment or caseload review, an MDT meeting, or as part of more formal reviews such as Education and Health Care Plan meetings or Looked after Child Reviews.


If there are safeguarding concerns at any point, please complete the S1 Safeguarding template as a precedent.

Within the template, on the "landing page", there are two view boxes to help aid your work.

- 1. All Inclusive Communication template link This is so healthcare professionals can see the communication needs of patients, so that they can consider if communication needs to be altered or adapted when providing Information, empowering choice and decision making. - Referrals and Communications and Assessment view there to aid MDT working over CCYPS and other services using S1. The view enables all open referrals and any recent assessments/discharge summaries from services to be viewed.






















