



NCEPOD Community Acquired Pneumonia Study

- NCEPOD is undertaking a study to identify and explore avoidable and modifiable factors in the care of adults presenting to hospital with a presumed diagnosis of community acquired pneumonia.
- Data will be collected from all hospitals in England, Wales, and Northern Ireland, that admit patients with CAP. Patients must be aged 18 and over and admitted to hospital between **1st October 2021 - 31st December 2021** with a primary admission diagnosis of CAP.
- Retrospective study period: **1st October 2021 - 31st December 2021 inclusive**
- **Exclusions:**
 - ❖ Patients under the age of 18
 - ❖ Patients presenting to hospital within 10 days of being discharged, where the discharge diagnosis of prior admission was not CAP
- **Patients will be identified retrospectively for the study** via completion of a data collection spreadsheet via ICD10, ECDS and SNOMED codes
- **Data Collection:** a clinical questionnaire, GP clinical and community organisational questionnaire, an organisational questionnaire, and a peer review of case note extracts
- **Clinical reviewers will be recruited for the peer review of case notes** (Recruitment Date **TBC**) Please see: <https://www.ncepod.org.uk/cap.html>
