



## NCEPOD Crohn's Disease Study

- NCEPOD is undertaking a study to explore the remediable factors in the quality of care provided to patients aged 16 and over with a diagnosis of Crohn's disease who underwent a surgical procedure.
- Adult patients (aged 16 and over) who were admitted to hospital for a surgical procedure for Crohn's disease. Patients can be admitted electively or as an emergency.
- Retrospective study period: **1st September 2019 – 29<sup>th</sup> February 2020 and 1st September 2020 – 28<sup>th</sup> February 2021 inclusive**
- **Exclusions:**
  - Patients under the age of 16
- **Patients will be identified retrospectively for the study** via completion of a data collection spreadsheet using ICD10 and OPCS codes
- **Data Collection: a clinical questionnaire** to the named clinician who was responsible for the patient's care at the time of their admission; an **organisational questionnaire**, and **case note extracts** for peer review
