



NCEPOD Endometriosis Study

- NCEPOD is undertaking a study to review remediable factors in the quality of care provided to patients aged 18 and over, with a diagnosis of endometriosis.
- **The data collection spreadsheet is designed to identify all patients, aged 18 and over, with a diagnosis of endometriosis during the study period.**
- Retrospective study period: **1st February 2018 to the 31st July 2020**
- **Patients will be identified retrospectively for the study** via completion of a data collection spreadsheet using ICD10, OPCS, ECDS and SNOMED codes
- **Data collection:**
 - **clinical questionnaire** to the named gynaecologist who was responsible for the patient's care at the time of their admission
 - **primary care clinician questionnaire** sent to the identified general practitioner
 - **organisational questionnaire**
 - **case note extracts** for peer review
 - anonymous **patient survey** (not linked to the case review)
- **Clinical reviewers are being recruited for the peer review of case notes.**
