

NCEPOD Endometriosis Study

- NCEPOD is undertaking a study to review remediable factors in the quality of care provided to patients aged 18 and over, with a diagnosis of endometriosis.
- The data collection spreadsheet is designed to identify all patients, aged 18 and over, with a diagnosis of endometriosis during the study period.
- Retrospective study period: 1st February 2018 to the 31st July 2020
- Patients will be identified retrospectively for the study via completion of a data collection spreadsheet using ICD10, OPCS, ECDS and SNOMED codes
- Data collection:
 - **clinical questionnaire** to the named gynaecologist who was responsible for the patient's care at the time of their admission
 - primary care clinician questionnaire sent to the identified general practitioner
 - **o** organisational questionnaire
 - o case note extracts for peer review
 - o anonymous **patient survey** (not linked to the case review)
- Clinical reviewers are being recruited for the peer review of case notes. Closing Date: 12th December 2022. Please see <u>www.ncepod.org.uk/endometriosis</u> for details.
