

What are we collecting?



We are asking doctors their thoughts on how to improve care for patients who had a chest drain inserted during a hospital admission.



We are asking patients their thoughts on the care received during and after their chest drain was inserted.




A survey will also be open to doctors and nurses to ask for their opinions on if they feel confident and competent to carry out these type of procedures

We will then delete your healthcare information.


